

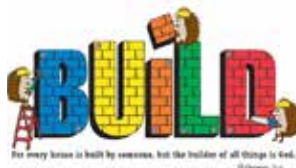

Galilee is a new orphanage being constructed and at the moment progress has ground to a halt at 90% completion. This is home

to 36 kids and most of the building is still not habitable.

The walls and roof are in place but windows, floors, fixtures, furnishings, and electrical have not been funded yet. Building projects are difficult for us because we have two huge mandates that always come first. They are 1- The daily needs of the children already under care and 2- The rescue of children in great danger who are within our reach. But God is so very faithful and He is our provider.
