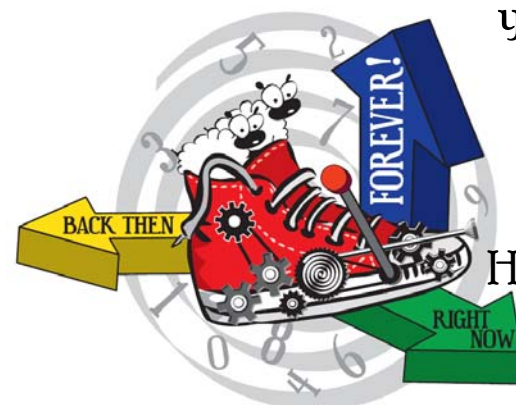

Through his efforts to reorganize and regulate the church of the Franks, he helped shape Western Christianity, and many of the dioceses he proposed remain until today. After his martyrdom, he was quickly hailed as a saint in Fulda and other areas in Germany and in England. Boniface is celebrated (and criticized) as a missionary; he is regarded as a unifier of Europe, and he is seen as a German national figure.

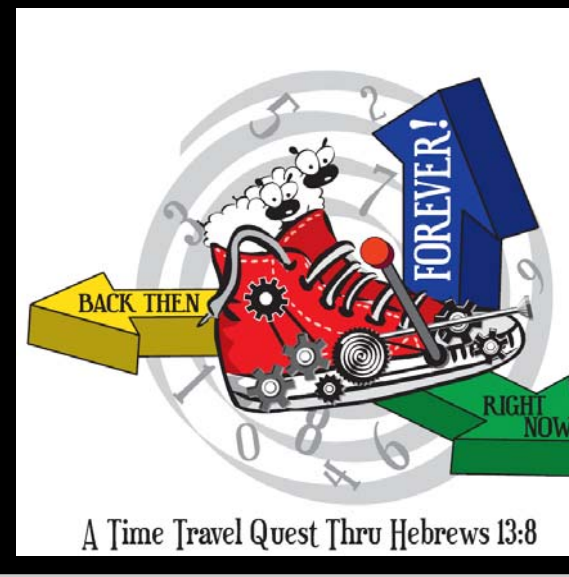
